THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NO.507011 IN THE PARISH OF BURTON-IN-KENDAL) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the traffic authority for Footpath No. 507011 in the Parish of Burton-in-Kendal is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said road (footpath) should be restricted by reason of works being proposed to be executed thereon and near the road ("the Works").

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

- 1. No person shall proceed along an approx. 420 metre section of Public Footpath No. 507011 at Burton Woodland in the Parish of Burton in Kendal between Grid References: 352870 477659 and 352799 477253.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty sixth day of October 2020 may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Footpath No.507011 in the Parish of Burton-in-Kendal) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2020.
