**Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held in Burton-in-Kendal Memorial Hall on Thursday
15th June 2023 at 7.30pm**

1) APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllrs Taylor, Isherwood and Wilson

2) DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND APPLICATIONS FOR DISPENSATION:

3) MINUTES OF THE LAST PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD

The previous minutes were approved and signed by the Chairman.

4) RECEIVE ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM CHAIRMAN

- a) Burton News have requested the funding previously agreed – this will be added to July Agenda for payment.
- b) Burton Education Trust have requested that a representative from the Parish Council attend meetings. It was agreed that if no Councillor could attend the Clerk would represent Council.

5) OPEN FORUM

4 members of the public were in attendance.

- a) Moira Rowley has requested assistance from the Parish Councillors following a fire on Boon Town. The water hydrant were on low pressure causing issues for the Fire service and also one hydrant appears to be have been tarmacked over. Clerk to contact United Utilities and Cumbria Fire Service.
- b) A member of the Recreation Trust expressed concern following the mention of a break in and drugs at the MUGA in the previous meeting minutes. This was an unconfirmed report and the Committee can confirm that there was no drugs involved. The Parish Council also confirmed that the previous funding of the grass cutting and maintenance was only agreed on an annual basis and as no requests had been made to the Parish Council and in order to cut costs the PC would only be providing half the funding for this year.

Councillor Hughes was unable to attend the meeting but had circulated a short report.

7) CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL AND AGREE FUNDING FOR CORONATION GARDEN AT BURTON MOREWOOD SCHOOL

Due to a Governors' Meeting there was no representative in attendance to present the proposal. It was confirmed that the £800 previously agreed is still available and the item would be put forward to the July Meeting.

Clerk informed councillors that a safety report is required on the condition of the trees at the '19 Tree' junction. A quotation of £300 has been submitted and it was agreed by Councillors that this reports needs to be done as soon as possible and recommendations can be at July Meeting. Clerk to instruct Cumbria Tree Surveys.
