GENERAL HEALTH AND CARE GIVERS

225 people (16.0%), indicated that they have a long term illness that limits their daily activities or the work they can do. In Cumbria, the percentage of people with a limiting long term illness is 20%. 1003, or 71.4% indicated that their general health was good. In Cumbria, 67.1% of the total population were enjoying good health.

HOUSEHOLD DETAILS

In Burton-in-Kendal, there are 601 household spaces with residents. There are also a further 19 which are vacant, and 10 which are either second or holiday homes. The average household size in this parish is 2.34 people.
